Students are expected to:

- Complete all English and Chinese assignments. This includes all in-class and homework activities.
- Participate to the best of their ability in all learning situations.
- Be fluent in either English or Mandarin.

Parents / guardians must:

- Accept admission to the program by completing and returning an acceptance form by **Wednesday, May 9, 2012.**
- Make sure their child has satisfactory attendance and on-time arrival.
- Ensure that their child completes assigned homework and returns it on time.

By signing below, we agree that we have read and understood the above statement and make a conscientious commitment to remain at Southeast for the entirety of the program. We understand that this is a K-4 program at Southeast, with continuing Chinese opportunities in upper grades.

All application materials must be turned in to the appropriate office by **March 30, 2012, by 5:00pm.** If they are not returned by this date, the student will not be included in the initial round of the lottery selection for the next school year. Please note that the applications must be turned in to the Southeast Elementary office in person or by postal mail. Applications will not be accepted by fax or by email.
